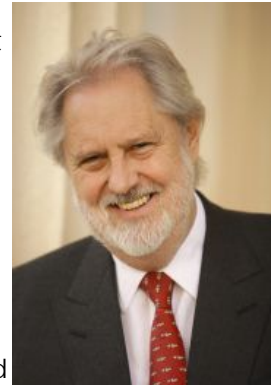

#### Lord David Puttnam

David has spent 30 years as an independent film producer, winning many awards for films including The Mission, the Killing Fields, Local Hero, Chariots of Fire, Midnight Express, Bugsy Malone, and Memphis Belle. He was Chair and Chief Executive Officer of Columbia Pictures from 1986 to 1988 - the only non-American ever to run a Hollywood Studio. He retired from film production to focus on his work in education. He was Chancellor of the University of Sunderland, and recently became Chancellor of the Open University. He was the founder and is Chair of Trustees of the National Teaching Awards and was the first Chair of the General Teaching Council for England. He was Vice President and Chair of Trustees at BAFTA, and was awarded a BAFTA Fellowship in 2006. In the same year, he became Deputy Chairman of Channel Four, Chairman of Futurelab and Chairman of Profero. In 2002, David was appointed President of UNICEF UK and was awarded a CBE in the same year. He received a Knighthood in 1995 and was appointed to the House of Lords in 1997 where he was Chairman of the Climate Change Bill's Joint-Parliamentary Scrutiny Committee.
